Unfortunately, you may have received or heard about emails being sent out by a disgruntled party member who has made a habit of making off base complaints and wild accusations. For those who have been party members for a while, you know that he does this every year and you may already be disregarding them. For those who have recently joined, these accusations may be alarming and that is why although most of what is said should be disregarded, we feel it is necessary to address a few of the points.

First, the party is not in financial distress. We have been and will meet all financial obligations and there is absolutely no truth to this claim. Further, the Party financial records are filed and posted on-line with the State Campaign Spending commission and Federal Elections Commission regularly as required. These requirements require our finances to be completely open and transparent so calls for an audit and accusations of financial impropriety are bizarre, our financial records are available for all the public to see.

In addition, the insinuation that somehow spending too much money during the election was irresponsible is comical. Political parties exist to spend their money on campaigns and that is what we did. This criticism is only valid if you would rather see the party hoard money and not spend it on winning elections.
